Wellness

Please remember to follow the Wellness Policy and get a backup person in the event that your child gets sick and you find it difficult to leave work during the day. As a reminder, children must be fever free for 24 hours (without fever reducing medications) and vomiting/diarrhea free for 24 hours (able to have a regular stool in the case of diarrhea) before returning. If your child has a contagious illness, we would appreciate you letting us know. It is helpful to know what's going around so that we can look for patterns and be proactive. When visiting the doctor due to a contagious illness, please bring a note each time stating when the child may return. If you will be staying home for the day due to illness, please call and tell us. The sooner we can catch hold of an illness trend, the sooner we can work to extinguish it!

One last thing concerning keeping children healthy, please wash your child's hands each and every morning as part of your drop off routine. What a great way to start your day - germ free!! 😊😊
