# Wakisa Crisis Pregnancy Center

For almost 7 years, UORF has been partnering with Wakisa Crisis Pregnancy Center to provide abstinence counseling and alternatives to illegal abortions. The center also provides training for the girls in cookery, gardening, tailoring, computers, and Bible class. Many of the **UORF** teams have visited Wakisa and received such a blessing learning about their program. One of the girls recently taken in at Wakisa was deaf, so the staff and the other girls learned some basic sign language. During September, 5 healthy babies were born to girls at Wakisa. UORF is thankful for this ministry we can partner with.

## **Bethel Children's Home**

### Kyannanjula, Masaka District

During the February visit to Kyannanjula, the US team was asked by local leadership to add several orphans to the program. Some home visits were made by the US team and follow-up was done by the Ugandan team. This spring, 11 children were added to the UORF program in Kyannanjula. Several of the orphans remain living with their guardian nearby and walk to school. The rest joined the Bethel Children's Home and return to guardians during school breaks.

With a special gift from a Bethel CRC Lansing member, new beds were added, bedding & mosquito nets were purchased, and minor repairs were made at the home.

In July, the UORF nurse treated several cases of malaria and diarrhea. Testing was done for malaria, typhoid, and H pylori. All children at the home tested negative for HIV!
