Therefore, I make a motion from the Board of Trustees to ratify the Church Council action on 6/20/2020 to approve expenditure of \$4800 from the Bldg/Maint Fund for Urgent Termite treatment by Dr. Termite upon the entire building and grounds. Work was done on June 30 & July 1.


