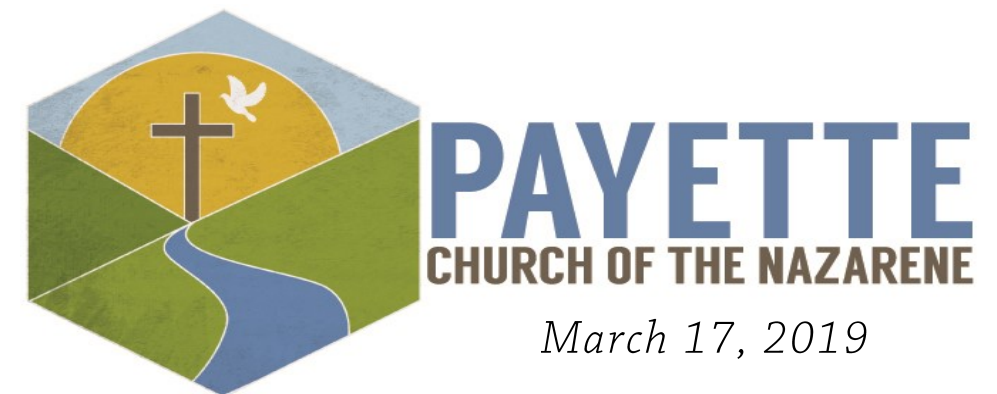

There will be at least one Pastor available to serve you throughout the week.

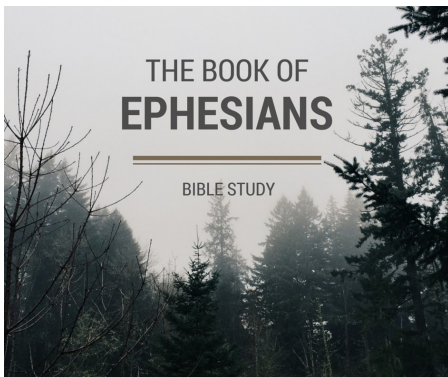
