

- Volunteers may serve in the Safe House Thrift Store located at 230 N. Spring, Cape Girardeau, MO. Volunteers assist in sorting through donated items, stocking and replenishing merchandise, and assisting shoppers in the store

- The Safe House also is developing a mentoring program to help women and their families learn how to budget finances, develop childcare skills, and also development skills that will help them gain or sustain employment in the community. Female volunteers are needed to mentor the residents of the Safe House as they enter back into their own homes.
- Individuals or small groups may “adopt” a room in the Safe House, providing bedding, curtains and room decor for the women and children staying at the Safe House. As families leave, they are able to take the bedding and curtains with them; therefore, adoption of the room would be an ongoing endeavor with need based upon the length of stay by the women and their families.
