Chris Scarberry Scholarship: Amount \$1000

- Chris Scarberry was a very bright student and a National Merit Finalist. He loved hanging out with his friends from Cy Creek High School, Lakewood UMC & Windwood Presbyterian.
- Preference given to any high school student attending U.M. Army or any other Senior High mission trip
- Scholarship recipients should be an active participant of LUMC
- The scholarship will be based on intent, heart for mission, not for those with highest GPA, but at least a GPA of 2.5

LUMC Mens Group Scholarship: Amount \$1000

- The LUMC Men’s Group has a history of providing support to our youth groups both financially and with our presence.
- The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize high school seniors who were active participant in the youth groups of Lakewood Methodist Church.

- Preference will be given to students' age 17 to 22 attending a college or university for education in the field(s) of art, graphic design, visual arts or ministry.
- Scholarship recipients must be an active participant of Lakewood United Methodist Church.
- The scholarship(s) will be based on intent, need or promise, not necessarily those who have the highest grade point average but applicants should have at least a grade point average of 2.5.

Aubrey Carr Contemporary Worship Scholarship: Amount \$500

The registrar at your high school must be contacted and instructed to send a copy of your transcript to LUMCScholarships@gmail.com. Alternatively, if you already have an official transcript, please scan and submit with your application. Exception – not required for Rusty Watkins Scholarship.

Essay

Describe in 500 words or less how your participation in Lakewood UMC activities and your high school achievements have prepared you for college and contributed to your spiritual growth.

Please share in a separate document any addition information that you deem necessary to highlight your participation in the scholarship areas that you have selected.

Confidential Reference Forms (Optional)

You may optionally submit up to 3 personal references. If you choose to include references, ask each person to write a reference and to send it directly to Lakewood UMC (Attn: Krista Wall). Alternatively, if the person providing a reference wishes to furnish this information electronically, please ask each person writing a reference to send it via email to LUMCScholarships@gmail.com and include your name in the subject line.

SAT or ACT Report (Optional)

Submit a copy of your SAT or ACT report. This is not required for Rusty Watkins Scholarship.
