# Housing Assistance

for survivors of domestic violence and their children

- Eligible applicants should:
  - Be homeless due to fleeing domestic violence
  - Not currently housed in a shelter
  - Interested in increasing income to become stably housed
  - Extremely low to low income (according to HUD guidelines)
- Program participation could be up to 1 year
- Participants selected without regard to race, age, gender, religion, national origin, educational level, sexual orientation, or disability.
- Goals of program:
  - Safety
  - Housing stability
  - Increased income/skills
  - Obtaining and maintaining mainstream benefits
