

**A REPORT FROM SAN MARINO FIRE CHIEF:**

Division Chief Mark Dondanville will be at the church at 0845 hours and prepared to address the congregation. He will be able to share some of the experiences of San Marino's Engine 91 from the Woolsey Fire.



At approximately 1:00 pm on Friday November 9, 2018 Engine 91 was deployed to the Malibu area as part of Strike Team 1364A for the Woolsey Fire in Ventura County/Los Angeles County. They worked nearly 48 hours without rest and helped save several homes. Engine 91 is expected to return to the City of San Marino on Saturday November 17, 2018. Engine 791 has been placed into service to protect the residents of San Marino while Engine 91 is helping with the wild-fires.
