




Giving With Venmo

What is Venmo?

Venmo is a free and secure service for collecting money and paying others from your smartphone or computer. It's a lot like PayPal, but without any service fees when you send money from your bank checking/savings account. (If you choose to give via credit card, Venmo charges a 3% service fee.)

How to give with Venmo:

- 1) **Download the**  **Venmo app** (or visit <https://venmo.com/signup> to sign up)
- 2) Sign up with either your **email address or your Facebook account**.
- 3) **Enter your cell phone number**. Venmo requires a number with text messaging capabilities, because they send you a code via text message to activate your account.

- 5) **Add San Marino Community Church**. Search People and enter **@smccpby**
