Health, Dental, Vision Examination & Immunization Requirements for School Attendance
2021-2022

The following items are required of all students attending school in the State of Illinois-

Students will **NOT** be able to attend school after **October 15, 2021** until **ALL** required information is received.

Requirements by Grade Level:

Preschool Students:

- Physical Exam
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor: (4) DTap, (3) Polio, (4) Hib, (3) Hep B, (1) MMR, (1) Varicella, (4) Pneumococcal
- Birth Certificate

Kindergarten Students:

- Physical Exam
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor: (5) DTap, (4) Polio, (4) Hib, (3) Hep B, (2) MMR, (2) Varicella, (4) Pneumococcal
- Dental Exam on Illinois form due on April 30, 2022 (dated within 18 months of deadline)
- Eye Exam on Illinois form dated within one year of the first day of school
- Birth Certificate

Second Grade Students:

- Dental Exam on Illinois form due April 30, 2022 (dated within 18 months deadline)

HEALTH EXAMS – A health exam must be completed no earlier than a year (365 days) prior to the start of attendance for students entering.....

- **Preschool**
 - **Kindergarten**
 - **6th grade**
 - **and students** entering an Illinois school from out-of-state or out-of-country for the first time at any grade level
- **NEW students to CLS**, regardless of age/grade, must submit health exam/immunization record within 30 days of registration
 - **Immunizations** – Vaccination against a number of communicable diseases at specified intervals is required

 - **Lead Screening** – Lead screening is a required part of the health examination for children age 6 or younger prior to admission to kindergarten
 - The required health exam/immunizations and lead screening may be obtained at the doctor’s office of your choice (chiropractic not accepted)
 - The *Certificate of Child Health Examination* Form labeled “11/15” must be used by students who need to provide proof of the physical exam for school year 2021-2022 (forms available at your doctor’s office)

 - **State law requires that students without the above exam and/or vaccinations are EXCLUDED from school attendance unless certain exceptions are met by October 15, 2021.** There are only two valid exemptions in Illinois to the above requirement---an exemption for a *medical* reason (written and signed by a health care provider), or for a *religious* reason (refer to <http://www.dph.illinois.gov/sites/default/files/forms/religious-exemption-form-081815-040816.pdf> for more information)

DENTAL EXAMS - All students in **Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th** grades are required to show proof of having an oral health exam
By April 30, 2022

- Examinations must be performed by a licensed dentist, and he/she must sign the *Proof of School Dental Examination* Form (available at your dentist’s office) <http://dph.illinois.gov/sites/default/files/forms/dentalexamform20191022.pdf>
- School dental examinations must have been performed *within* the 18 months prior to the deadline
- *Failure to submit proof of exam may result in a hold of the student’s report card.*

EYE EXAMS – All students enrolling in **Kindergarten** and/or **any student enrolling for the first time** are required to have an eye exam *by September 30, 2021.*

- Exams must be performed by a licensed optometrist or ophthalmologist. He/she shall complete and sign the *Eye Examination Report* Form (available at your eye doctor’s office)

- Eye examinations must be performed *within* one year prior to the first day of the school year
- *Failure to submit proof of exam may result in a hold of the student’s report card.*
