Concordia Lutheran School is a community of faith where we believe that each child is a unique creation of God, blessed with a special set of talents and gifts.

We feel that each child deserves the opportunity to develop his or her God-given potential to the fullest in all areas of life: spiritual, intellectual, creative, social, psychological, and physical.

Concordia Lutheran School understands the important role that parents play in the education of their children. It is with the cooperation and teamwork with parents, students, and staff that we strive to work together for a faith community that is alive where children can grow and learn.

1. Students are to work to the best of their ability at all times. Parents agree to work with staff to insure the best education for their children. Students are expected to be at grade level.
2. Parents and students must read and agree to abide by the "Student/Parent Handbook." This includes the uniform dress code as well as expected student behavior.
3. Verbal or physical abuse between students will not be tolerated. Repeated violation of student expectations can impact continued enrollment at Concordia Lutheran School.
4. Parents must support the behavioral interventions of the school. All classroom behavioral actions and suspensions must be fulfilled as assigned.
5. Quality education requires that students be in attendance, and on time to school each day. Students whose attend falls below 75% through either excused or unexcused absences, may be held at the same grade level during the following school year. Being at school and ready to begin promptly at 8:00am (8:15am for preschool) is important for the student to begin the morning focused on the activities for the day.
6. Attitudes are important to the success of the school. We believe that attitudes are an important part of the learning process and that attitudes of both the student and the parents are critical. The students, parents, and the school must all cooperate and work together as a team for the ultimate benefit of the student. Negative attitudes which carry- over in student relations, class work, and/or cooperation with staff will not be tolerated.
7. When the principal is out of the building and a member of the administration staff needs to discipline a student, they are doing so for the principal. The staff works closely with the principal and is well informed on the discipline guidelines. If you have a concern with the discipline administered by the staff you may contact the principal when he returns.
8. Unwillingness by a student or parent to cooperate with the teacher and the administration when problems arise resulting in unresolved issues will result in consideration for withdrawal/dismissal.
