



## **CAMPGROUND PROTOCOL FOR NON-SEASONAL CAMPERS**

---

**Revised June 17, 2020 and in effect until further notice**

- Campers and guests of OVPC are expected to visit in alignment with government guidelines for social distancing
- Campers are encouraged to wash their hands as they enter and leave their accommodation
- The office remains open for assistance and payment through phone and email
- Groundskeeper inquires and assistance may be scheduled through phone and email
- Common gathering areas including recreational facilities, playground, campfire pit, and public washrooms remain closed at this time
- Social distancing measures are to be used while walking/biking on the camp roads and hiking trails
- Children under the age of 10 are not to be walking/biking on the camp roads or hiking trails without adult accompaniment to ensure social distancing measures are demonstrated
- The laundromat will open beginning Monday, June 29 during the hours of Monday at 9 a.m. through Friday at 4 p.m. (closed on weekends)
- The beach is open for recreational use, with the exception of the water slide, with the understanding that it is unsupervised and must be used at visitor's own risk
- The lifeguard shack remains closed at this time, and therefore borrowing of lifejackets is not available

**Please do not visit the campground if you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, or have had contact with anyone experiencing symptoms or who have tested positive for COVID-19.**
