



CAMPGROUND PROTOCOL FOR CAMPERS WITH SEASONAL CONTRACT

In effect Friday, June 11, 2021 until further notice

- Leaseholders are expected to visit in alignment with government guidelines for social distancing and outdoor gathering limits of 10 people
- To comply with OVPC's Guest Facilities Screening protocol, leaseholders must sign-in and complete the self-screening questionnaire in the log book found at the entrance of the campground upon arriving and continue to self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms each day of their stay
- Leaseholders are encouraged to wash their hands as they enter and leave their trailer
- Leaseholders renting their trailer must submit the online 'Guest Notification Form' to ensure necessary documents are shared from the office
- The office remains open for assistance and payment through phone and email
- Groundskeeper inquires and assistance may be scheduled through phone and email
- Camp tools, lawnmowers, and equipment are currently not available for use
- Leaseholders are encouraged to bring their own tools to use for trailer repairs
- Leaseholders using recreational facilities, beachfront, playground, and campfire pit must adhere to the posted regulations at these given areas
- Public washrooms and camp buildings will only be open while OVPC is hosting events
- Social distancing measures are to be used while walking/biking on the camp roads and hiking trails
- Children under the age of 10 are not to be walking/biking on the camp roads or hiking trails without adult accompaniment to ensure social distancing measures are demonstrated
- Social distancing guidelines are to be followed while using watercraft and when accessing watercraft around boat launch and storage racks
- The Waterfront Shed remains closed at this time, and therefore borrowing of lifejackets is not available

Please do not visit the campground if you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, or have had contact with anyone experiencing symptoms or who have tested positive for COVID-19.
