Scholarships are open to students who:

- Meet all the requirements for admission to the school of choice.

Scholarship applicant requirements:

- Applicants must meet all the requirements for admission to the college or university of their choice for undergraduate work or a medical degree for a maximum of six (6) years.
- The school of choice may be private or state supported college, a junior college or a university or an accredited Trade or Technical School.
- A MINIMUM of 12 hrs. per semester must be carried by the applicant.
- This scholarship will be awarded without regard to other scholarships received by the applicant from other entities.
- The total amount of the scholarship will be disbursed on August 1st.
- Incomplete applications or late applications will not be considered.
- FUMC membership as well as the level of activity in the programs and ministries of the church will be given high priority. Member families will be considered when funds are available.
- Grades will be considered and must be satisfactory.
- Financial need will be a factor, but not of primary importance.
- Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis.
