Dwelling in Spring

Spring has sprung, even with the recent freeze warnings. The eggs have hatched and we have a nest full of baby birds in the crook of the cross outside the church's south entryway. Our congregation garden is waiting, as the fields are, for just the right time for planting. (More information about how you can participate in caring for the garden this year is coming soon!)

Thank you all for your prayers and encouragement following Matt's knee replacement surgery. As I write, it has been one week, and he is healing and improving each day. It's hard for him to imagine right now, but I know that he'll soon be back on the golf course (and back in the pulpit!).

April was a busy month, beginning with Holy Week. I want to express my gratitude to all those who helped make our observance of Holy Week possible. FLC staff and volunteers worked together to make 9 worship services and 3 congregational meals possible over the course of 9 days. We celebrated a baptism and First Communion and commended a brother in Christ into God's care. Thank you to our meal teams, fellowship volunteers, lectors, altar guild, ushers, communion assistants, nursery attendants, musicians, projection assistants, counters, and everyone who said "yes!" when one of us called or emailed with a job for you. Thank you to our entire staff, who worked hard to make everything come together.

April also saw the conclusion of our Faithtime programming on Wednesdays. Our final day of Faithtime Kids and Faithtime Meal was April 19, and our final day for Confirmation Class was April 26. We served over 40 children in our Faithtime Kids program and had 17 students in Confirmation this year. Thank you to all of our dedicated volunteers for those programs for a year completed and job well done!

During the month of May, we find a new rhythm at First Lutheran. We continue to celebrate the joy of Christ's resurrection, as the Easter season lingers. At the end of the month, our Easter celebration will culminate with Pentecost. We will remember Jesus's ascension to heaven and the gift of the Holy Spirit, the birth of the Church. We will rejoice that God uses us – Jesus' disciples – to share the good news with the whole world.

We will celebrate and support the ministry of First Lutheran Preschool with Mayfest on May 7. Friday, May 12 we will host Trivia Night, a fundraiser for ELCA World Hunger. I'm getting my team together now, and hope to have plenty of good competition that evening! May 14 will be our Graduate Recognition Sunday, as we celebrate and bless our High School Seniors. May 20 & 21 is Compassion International Weekend, and you will have an opportunity to choose a child to sponsor through the organization Compassion International. May 27 & 28 we will celebrate Pentecost.

In the middle of the month, Pastor Matt and I are planning to attend the Festival of Homiletics in Minneapolis. We will be out of the office, but still reachable by phone and email, May 15-18. This event is a gathering of outstanding preachers from many Christian traditions, sponsored by Luther Seminary. We will worship, hear the good news preached, and attend workshops to help us enhance our preaching. It's been described as "summer camp for preachers."

I am ready for summer, and especially preacher summer camp, but not too eager for spring to be over. It is good to enjoy God's goodness in springtime, when there's still a chill in the air, or at least a cool breeze overnight even when days get hot. The fiery tongues of Pentecost and the scorching days of summer can wait until the end of May, so that we can enjoy the remainder of the Easter season and the beauty of springtime.

This 5-day camp for children ages 7-11 provides a 2:1 camper to counselor ratio so that individual attention can be provided, and the children feel safe, have fun, and experience unconditional love. They discover self-worth and a feeling of success as they accomplish projects and make friends. RFKC can be a life-changing experience.

Camp activities include games, woodworking, craft projects, music, swimming, fishing, canoes, paddle boats, and a rock-climbing wall. Each child leaves camp with a special quilt and a photo album, so the positive memories can be recalled all year long!
