(PSALN	// 119:45) $-$ ⁴⁵ I will walk about in freedom, for I have sought out your precepts.
(JOHN	$8:36$) – 36 So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.
	FIANS 5:1) – It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be ed again by a yoke of slavery.
Historically, there were 2 categories of Covenants:

•	Covenant – one more powerful than the other
