MATTHEW 1:1-17 (The genealogy of Jesus)

1 – (BOOK OF GENESIS)

- Abraham...Isaac...Jacob... – (God made a covenant with this family)
- JUDAH – *GENESIS 38* (his sons died, and he mistakenly impregnated his daughter-in-law, TAMAR)
 - Tamar gave birth to twins: Perez and Zerah

2 – (EGYPTIAN SLAVERY)

- Hezron (son of Perez)...Ram...Amminadab – (all slaves in Egypt, who cried out to God for mercy)
- Nahshon – (*NUMBERS 2...crossed Red Sea, wandering in the wilderness*)

3 – (BACK IN PROMISED LAND)

- Salmon married RAHAB – (*JOSHUA 15...Judah was given the territory around Bethlehem*)
- Boaz – (born to Salmon and Rahab)

4 – (KING DAVID FAMILY)

- Boaz married a girl named RUTH (*she was a Moabite girl, and a widow...following her mother-in-law*)
- Obed was their son. He eventually had a son, Jesse
- And Jesse was the father of King David
- KING DAVID – the greatest of Israel's kings had SOLOMON...
 - WHOSE MOTHER HAD BEEN URIAH'S WIFE – (This is Bathsheba)
