Praise Team Worship Vocalists (3352)

Assist in praise and worship by singing with praise team during the 11:00 a.m. worship service, and occasional special worship events. Solo and small group harmonizing abilities are important, an interview & vocal evaluation required.

Time: 1-2 Wed. evenings/month (6:30-9 pm) & Sun. a.m. when scheduled

Praise Team Worship Instrumentalists (3360)

Assist in praise and worship by playing your instrument with the praise band for the 11:00 a.m. worship service, and at occasional special worship events. Proficiency on your instrument is required, as well as ability to read or follow music and/or chord charts.

Instrumentalists should be able to play in an ensemble setting. Improvisation and solo skills not required, but a plus; experience in a band not required, but definitely an asset.

Time: 1-2 Wed. evenings/mo. (6:30-9 pm) & Sunday a.m. when scheduled

Reader – 8:30 Service (3367)

Read designated scripture at the 8:30 a.m. Worship service.

Time: 1x/quarter as scheduled

Seasonal Choir (3356)

A choral group that prepares music for worship during the Christmas and Easter seasons. Sings when scheduled, usually 1-3 times/season, with rehearsal on Thursday nights as scheduled. No audition required.

Time: When scheduled during the holidays, & Thursday nights when scheduled.

Special Music Vocalists (3351)

Prepare and sing special music in worship as needed, possibly on a rotating schedule basis, at the discretion of the worship director. Other possibilities for involvement may include singing in duets, quartets, and other small groups. Live accompaniment is preferred, but tracks are also acceptable. Memorization by singers is not required, but highly encouraged.

Time: Specially scheduled rehearsals & Sundays scheduled

Special Music Instrumentalists (3359)

Prepare and play special music in services as needed, possibly on a rotating schedule basis at the discretion of the worship director. Other possibilities for involvement include playing in small groups and ensembles, accompanying choral numbers on occasion.

Time: Specially scheduled rehearsals, & Sundays as scheduled

Accompanists (Piano/Keyboard)

Play piano and/or keyboard for either or both 8:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. worship services. On occasion, accompany small groups, soloists, hymns, & congregational songs. Other possibilities for involvement include preparing preludes or preservice music, offertories, and/or postludes, and accompanying worship groups.

Time: As needed, may include evening rehearsals on occasion; Sundays as scheduled

Drama (3370)

Individuals are sometimes needed to perform short skits to dramatize and enhance the Sunday sermons. Other outreach dramas for Vacation Bible School narration, dramatic Scripture interpretations, and special events may also be a part of this ministry.

Time: Rehearsals & Sunday a.m. when needed.
