#### Discussion Questions (Luke 19:28-40)

1. Why do you think people are often fascinated with and sometimes even worship royalty? How might this relate to the purpose for which we were created? (*Isaiah 43:6-7*)
2. How does Jesus demonstrate his Kingship by sending two of two disciples to retrieve a donkey's colt? (*Luke 19:29-34; Colossians 1:16; Psalms 50:10*) What does the response of the colt's owner say about them? What does it teach us?
3. What does the fact that King Jesus rode into Jerusalem on the colt of a donkey teach us about him and his Kingship? How is Jesus different from other Kings? (*Zechariah 9:9; Matthew 11:28-30*)
4. How do Jesus' immediate disciples glorify him as their King? (*Luke 19:35*) How does the crowd of disciples glorify Jesus as their King? (*Luke 19:36-38; Psalms 118:26; Matthew 21:9*)
5. Why do you think the Pharisees wanted to stop the crowd from glorifying Jesus as their King? (*Luke 19:39*)
6. What does Jesus' response to the Pharisees say about who he is and why he should be worshipped by all? (*Luke 19:40; 1 Peter 3:22*)
7. How will Jesus' final and total Triumphal Entry be different from the first? (*Revelation 19:11-16*)
8. Is Jesus your King? If so, are you ready to give him everything he requires of you? Will you give King Jesus the worship, honor and glory he deserves? Will you bow your knee to him, giving your life in service to the King of kings and Lord of lords?
