## Day 1 Craft - Belt of Truth



- white or cream colored material, 21/4" width and around 50" length
- school glue
- letters to spell TRUTH
- felt foam sheets
- scissors
- markers
- glitter

## Day 2 Craft - Breastplate of Justice



**Preparation** Use the templates (on next page) to cut out the shape of breastplates on brown paper. Cut poster boards in the same shape using brown paper. Glue these items together. Make copies of the template with the word JUSTICE on it. Punch holes in top and bottom of breastplate and thread yarn through the holes.

- brown paper grocery bag or brown craft paper
- school glue
- posterboard
- hole punch
- yarn
- glue sticks
- markers
- glitter glue
- scissors
- washi tape
- dot markers (preschool only)

Day 3 - Shoes of Peace



**Preparation** Write the word PEACE on both socks with a black fabric/permanent marker. Tape the socks to the table. This will make it easier to color the socks.

- plain white socks (child-sized)
- black, green, and red colors of fabric markers/permanent markers
- other colors of fabric markers (optional)
- cardboard
- masking tape

Day 4 - Shield of Faith



Preparation Trace the shield template (on next page) onto the poster board and cut it out. Cut poster board into 2" strips to use as handles for the shields. Cut the blue squares. Cut out letters to spell "FAITH" from white construction paper. Cut paper into 1/4" squares.

- posterboard or recycled cereal boxes
- letter spelling out "FAITH"
- white construction paper
- paper in shades of blue
- markers, colored pencils, and crayons in varying shades of blue
- school glue
- duct tape and sturdy scissors (ADULT use only)

## Day 5 - Helmet of Salvation



- inexpensive hat or helmetcolorful foam sheets/stickers with adhesive backingsturdy scissors (ADULT use only)
