Paul the Apostle, writing to the church in Ephesus, says that he was “making mention of you in my prayers” Ephesians 1:16. Look at what He was praying about and know that this is our prayer for our friends as well.

We wish that you Know Jesus. Ephesians 1:17 says “that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him.” We are confident that there is no greater knowledge that you can have then to know that Jesus died, was buried, and then rose again for you (1 Corinthians 15:3-4). We are also confident that there is no greater knowledge that you can have then to know that He is still there to help you (1 John 2:1-2).

We wish that you Know Hope. Ephesians 1:18 says “I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling.” In the world there is plenty of fear (just turn on the news!). Yet with Jesus, there is hope. We can have hope that no matter what happens in this life, that He paid the price to save us from our sins and give us eternal life!

We pray that you Know Riches. No, we are not talking about the riches that will be spent, stolen or rust away. Rather “so that you will know...what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,” Ephesians 1:18. How rich is the man and women who allows Jesus to change their life! This person can see the rich blessings in salvation from sins, and in having a friendship with Jesus and a friendship with others who know Jesus.

We pray that you Know Power. Ephesians 1:19-20 says “and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe...when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places.” How much power is needed to raise someone from the dead? How much power is needed to help us get out of the mistakes that we have made for ourselves? Only a Holy God could do such a thing!

Special service projects and events for widows.




If you are in the 6th-12th grades, we want you to come be a part of a group that loves God, and each other


