Power of Leadership

Recently, I studied elders and deacons with a new Christian and recalled a saying from one of my college professors: "It is better to be biblically unorganized than unbiblically organized." In other words, having no elders or deacons is preferable to having unqualified ones. Unfortunately, many churches today appoint unqualified leaders simply to have some form of leadership, unaware of the severe consequences of such actions.

In the Old Testament, the rebel king Jeroboam rose to power by opposing Solomon and his son Rehoboam. He persuaded ten tribes to follow him in response to Rehoboam's strict policies. Although God was involved in these events (1 Kgs 11:31–32; 12:24), the sins of Jeroboam that followed were not from God. Jeroboam established two alternative worship sites at Bethel and Dan to prevent his people from traveling to Jerusalem. At each high place, he made a golden calf and appointed his own non-Levitical priests (1 Kgs 12:27–33; 2 Chr 13:8). Clearly, Jeroboam was not qualified to lead God's people spiritually, yet one man's influence was enough to draw many away from God.

This highlights the importance of selecting the right leaders in the church. God has provided qualifications for these men because He understands the significance of good leadership (1 Tim 3; Titus 1). However, many churches, even within our own fellowship, have abandoned these qualifications, viewing them merely as "qualities" or "suggestions." A single popular leader, like Jeroboam, can alter the worship practices of God's people and lead them into apostasy. If we do not hold our leaders to the standards God has set, we risk ending up with unbiblically organized churches led by unqualified men. We must trust that God has His reasons, even if His demands seem challenging or difficult to comprehend. God, who knows all things, has established these qualifications because He understands the potential consequences — He has witnessed them.
