

TRUTH & TRAINING (T&T): 3rd – 6th grade

Answers kids' key questions about God and the Bible –
guiding them to grow in His grace.



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Handbooks and large-group lessons deepen a child's knowledge about God and His Word and teach how to put that knowledge into action in everyday life.

CLUBS:

T&T is in the process of transitioning to new books. Previously, the books were split up by grade and became progressively harder. The new books are aimed at the middle 4th grade level so that all grades can use the book. Each year, Awana releases a new book, and we will be in the 3rd book this year. We have all grades (3rd-6th) working in the same handbook and rotate through the books in a 4 year cycle.

The new books use the Alltogether method. This method moves the clubbers together as a group from week to week and is designed to serve all the T&T kids. This method allows for fully integrated Large Group Time teaching and Small Group Time discussion which reinforces the weekly Bible concepts. This ensures that all kids understand and apply the Biblical concepts presented in each lesson, allows them to “drill down” into scripture for an in-depth understanding, before going further in the handbook. It keeps all kids on the same page in Large Group Time and allows for focused discussion during Small Group Time.

Grace in Action, Evidence of Grace, Agents of Grace

- Each book is broken up into 4 different sections.
- Each section has 8 lessons that cover different characteristics of each of the following topics:
 1. God Is
 2. The Bible
 3. Jesus / Redemption / I Am
 4. Grace / Evidence / Agents
- In each lesson, there are Bible Studies, additional memorization and missions update to take them further into the subject matter. The material must be recited with only two helps per section (not per verse).



Parents play the pivotal role in a child's spiritual nurturing.



If clubbers complete one section each week, he or she will complete their book within the club year. **PARENTS**, please help your clubber maintain this average by making sure they are prepared each week to recite their sections. Generally, leaders do not have time at club to teach the verses to your clubber.
