- God's Providence (v. 11) John 6:35; James 1:17
- God's Mercy (v. 12) 1 John 1:9; Psalm 103:12-13; Hebrews 8:11-12
- God's Protection (v. 13) 1 Corinthians 10:13; Ephesians 6:10-13a; 1 Peter 1:6-7
