Jesus came and stood among them... John 20:19

Jesus had told his disciples about this very moment

I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. John 14:18-19

And now I have told you before it takes place, so that when it does take place you may believe. John 14:29

When the disciples were in the throws of grief and fear Jesus appears and three times said “Peace be with you.”

Common Hebrew greeting (Judges 6:23, 19:20; 1 Sam 25:6; 3 John 1:15)

Peace is the gift of the Kingdom (John 14:27; 16:33) and the resurrection is the delivery of this peace.

John 20:25

Those closest to you can have the greatest doubts. Thomas spent years as a disciple yet didn't believe their testimony. (V25) For eight days Thomas didn't share what his fellow disciples shared – the awe of meeting the resurrected Christ. Imagine the tension of Thomas hearing talk of Jesus' resurrection 24/7 for eight days.

Thomas believed the evidence. "My Lord and my God!"

3. _____ in Christ is Eternal Life

...by believing you may have life in his name. John 20:31

The name:

Jesus the Christ

Jesus (gk "Iesous"): Jehovah is salvation (Ma 1:21)

Christ (gk "Christos): Messiah, anointed one
(Is 42:1; Ma 16:16; Luke 4:17-21; Acts 10:39-43)

Believing (gk "pisteuo"): To think to be true, to be persuaded of, to place confidence in, to trust.
