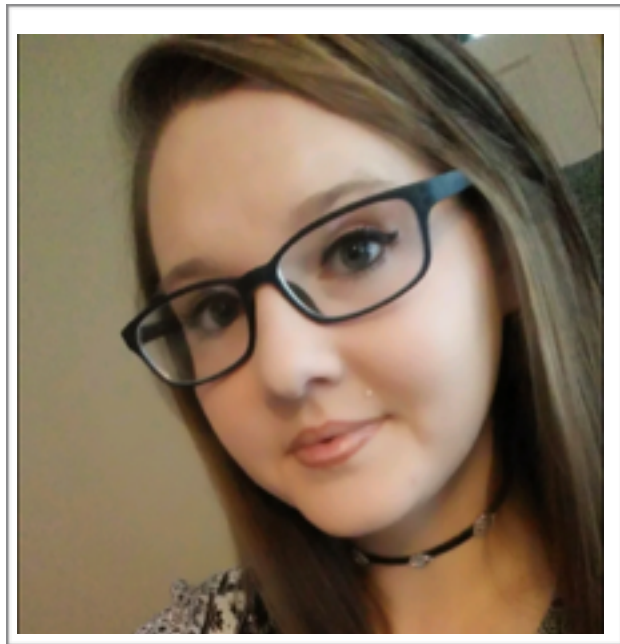

Mrs. Philadelphia Evans: Floater

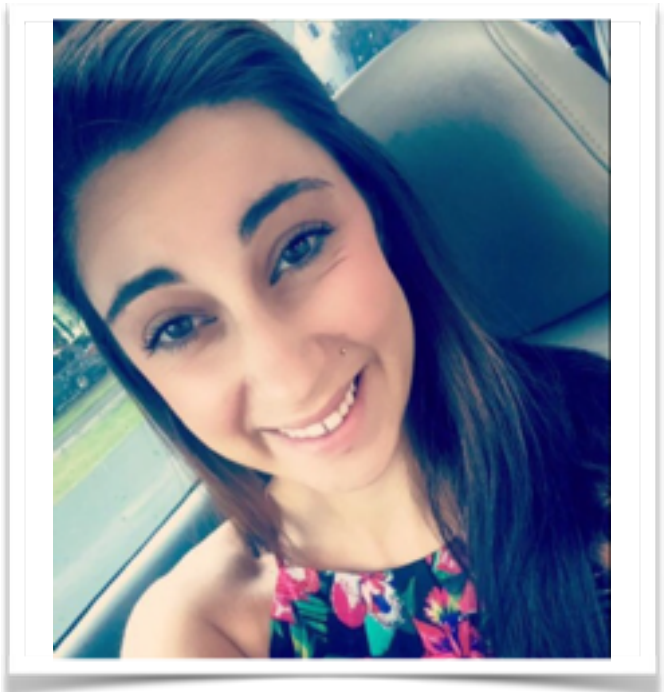

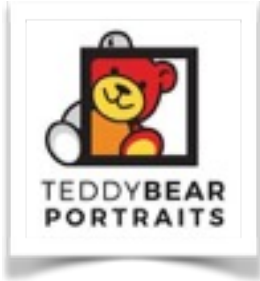
