We will begin the season of Lent with this service at the Kirk. As is our practice, this will be in partnership with our siblings of faith from Sixth Avenue UCC, Washington Park UCC, Park Hill UCC, Parkview UCC and others. Please plan to arrive early to welcome everyone into our space as we prepare our bodies and spirits for the season of Lent.

This Year's Lenton Practice: "Story Circles" (Starting February 25)

On Wednesday nights during Lent, all are invited to small-group sessions in the lower level. Each person may share a brief personal story in response to prompts like "Tell us a time you experienced compassion" or "A moment of surprise." Stories are shared one at a time, with no discussion—just listening. Afterward, we'll reflect on common themes and connect them to the story of Jesus. No preparation is needed! Attending all 6 weeks is encouraged so we can provide feedback to the Austin Story Project.

Kirk's Got Talent! March 8 at 4 p.m.

Over the years, we have witnessed the incredible talent at the Kirk, both from our youth and adults. We invite you to join us for our 6th Annual Talent Show! The signup sheet is located in the Narthex, so don't be shy—everyone is encouraged to share their gifts and talents in a relaxed, no-pressure atmosphere. Tickets will be available for purchase in the Narthex beginning February 22, and 100% of the proceeds will support our youth and children attending church camp as well as our service-learning trip to El Salvador.
