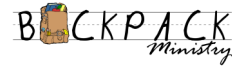

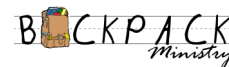

ONE TO GROW ON... *The Grow Team seeks to encourage our community of believers to grow deeper in relationship with Christ. Our prayer is that you will be inspired to forge new spiritual disciplines: to be intentional to make time every day to get alone with God (practice being in His Presence), to delve into His Word and allow it to penetrate your heart, and to develop new practices of daily prayer. To that end, here is ONE TO GROW ON... Sadly, in today's culture, many who profess to be Christians look much like those who have no such profession of faith. After the first Christian Pentecost, the Spirit emboldened the disciples, and lives were changed. They did not blend in with the culture. They stood for Christ. Believers today have that same Spirit; but the choice has to be made to reflect Christ instead of merely blending in with the culture. Rick Warren, author and preacher of Saddleback Church in California, explains it this way. "We can either be a thermometer or a thermostat wherever we go. A thermometer simply reflects the temperature of the environment. It reveals what the culture is like." On the other hand, a thermostat influences the temperature of the culture. "God wants you to be a thermostat." Are you willing?*
