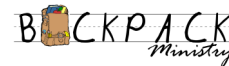
### UMW and EAGLES FLOWER SALE

### Intergenerational Worship on May 20 for the Musical



The only way to know if you have high blood pressure is to have your blood pressure tested. Understanding your blood pressure numbers is important to controlling high blood pressure. Your blood pressure is recorded as two numbers: **Systolic blood pressure** (the upper number) - indicates how much pressure your blood is exerting against your artery walls when the heart beats. **Diastolic blood pressure** (the lower number) - indicates how much pressure your blood is exerting against your artery walls while the heart is resting between beats. Typically, more attention is given to systolic blood pressure (the top number) as a major risk factor for cardiovascular disease for people over 50. However, elevated systolic or diastolic blood pressure alone may be used to make a diagnosis of high blood pressure. And, according to recent studies, the risk of death from ischemic heart disease and stroke doubles with every 20 mm Hg systolic or 10 mm Hg diastolic increase among people from age 40 to 89. **Stop by on Sunday May 6th and find out what your blood pressure numbers are—Health and Wellness team members will be in the Reception Room following both worship services.** <http://www.heart.org>
