Discussion Questions

- 1. **Read Galatians 5:1 and 5:13-14.** What types of slavery is Paul writing about? How is walking by the Spirit important for freedom? How are serving (vs 14) and freedom related?
- 2. **Read Galatians 5:19-24 and Romans 6:16-21.** What is the fruit of sin? What is the fruit of righteousness? How does this contrast help you understand the importance of maturity in the Spirit?
- 3. **Read 1 Timothy 1:15-16** How does Christ show patience for us? What is the purpose of this patience? Why is it so important for us to show patience with others? How do prayer and gratitude help us with patience?
- 4. Read Acts 14:8-10 How did Paul show the man kindness, active care and consideration? How does that apply to us today? Do you have moments of noticing people and "looking intently" where you have succeeded in showing kindness? Missed an opportunity? How did the Holy Spirit speak to you or empower you in those moments?
- 5. **Read Micah 6:8.** What "good" is expected of us? How does walking humbly empower us for good? Where do you have an opportunity, right now to do good, doing what is beneficial for others while loving and sharing Truth?
