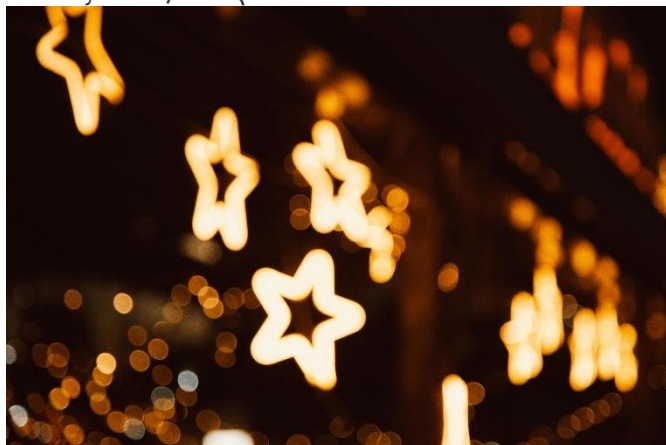
Christmas for Kids in Costa Rica!

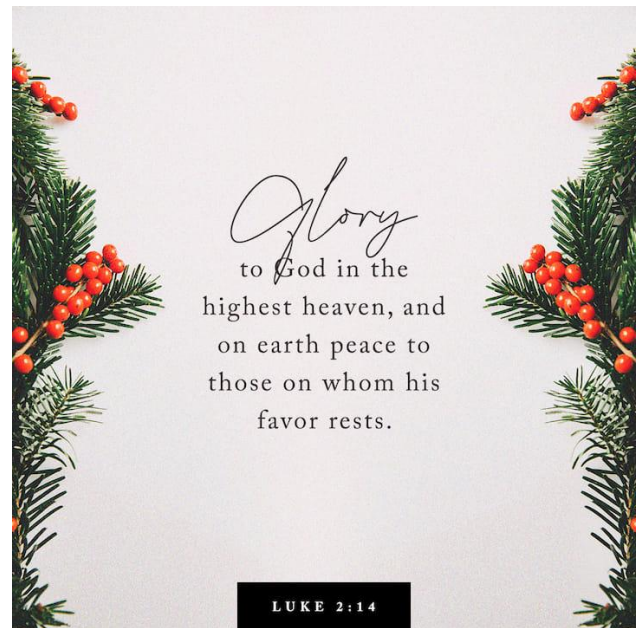
