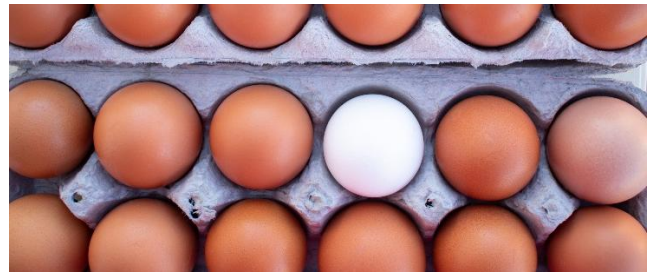
Message Series: 1 John

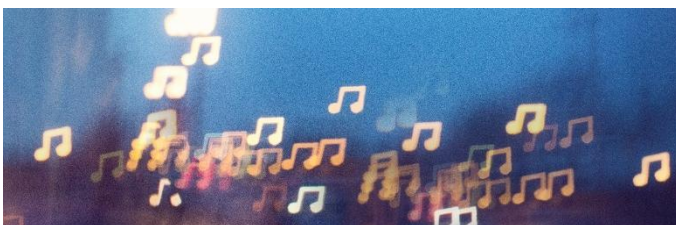

Soccer Shots @ LMC!

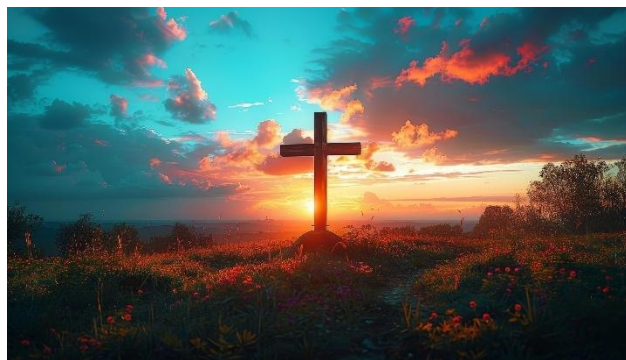

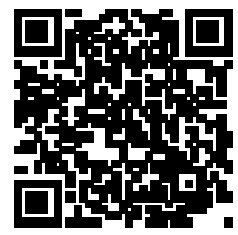
