Intergenerational Bible Study: The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe.

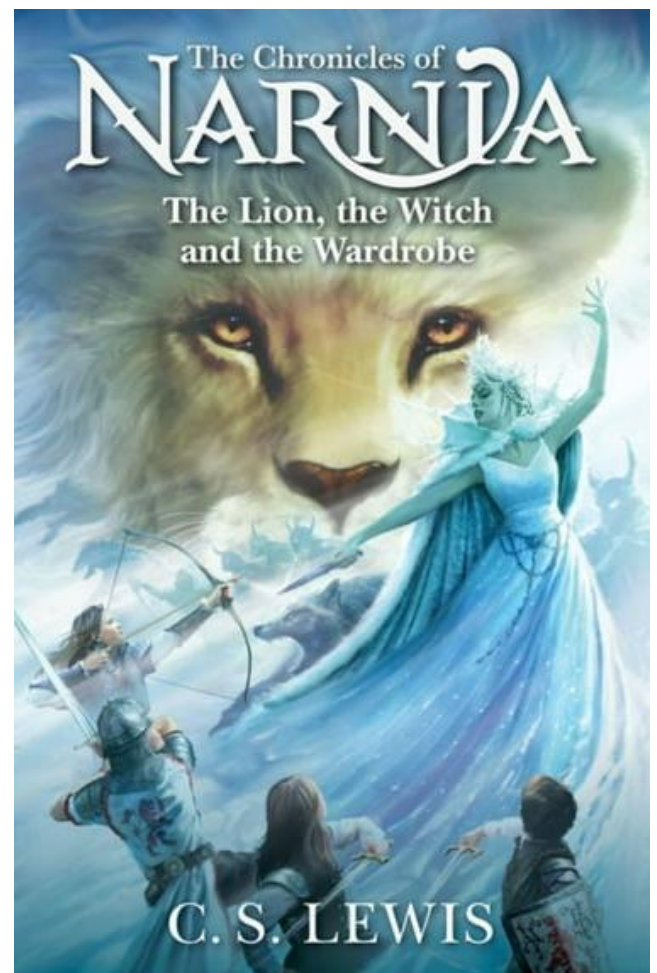
