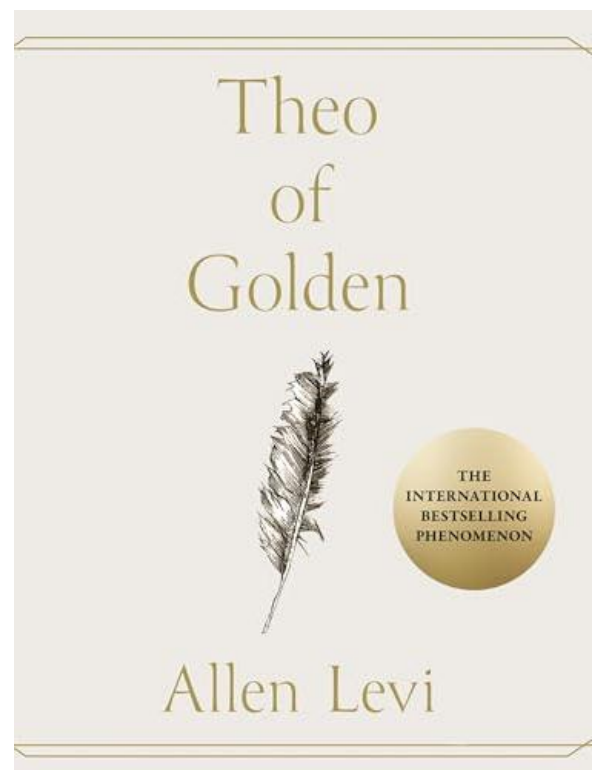
Summer Women’s Book Club!

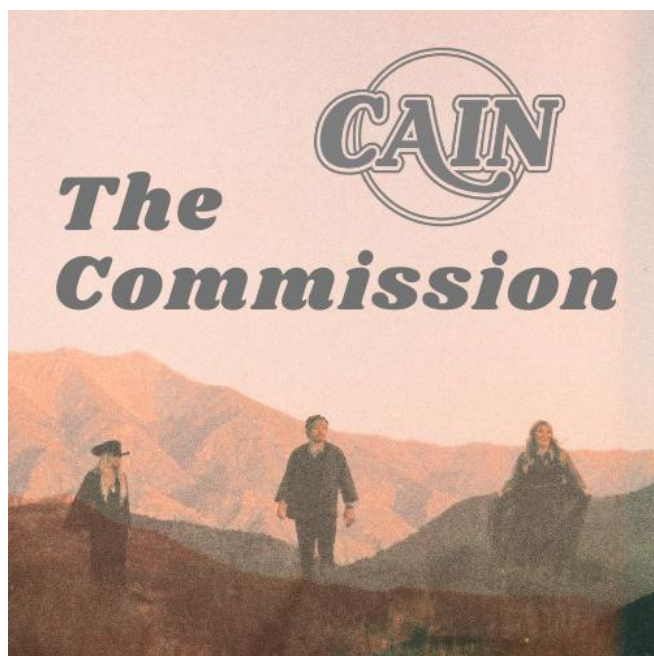

In exchange, he asks only for the person's story. And so portrait by portrait, person by person, secrets are revealed, regrets are shared, and ordinary lives are profoundly altered. A story of giving and receiving, of seeing and being seen, Theo of Golden is an unforgettable novel about the power of generosity, the importance of connection, and the quiet miracles that happen when we choose kindness and wonder.

I was introduced to this beautifully simple yet incredibly meaningful song a few years ago. Our upcoming sermon series is called SENT. This song was a breakout hit for the sibling trio CAIN. "[The Commission](#)" is a poignant contemporary Christian ballad that reimagines the final instructions of Jesus to His disciples (and to us). The song is written from the first-person perspective of Jesus as he prepares to ascend to heaven. Drawing directly from the "Great Commission" in **Matthew 28:19–20**, the lyrics serve as a direct mandate to believers: "Go tell the world about me / I was dead but now I live." It balances the sorrow of a "goodbye" with the hopeful promise that his Spirit remains with his followers. As we continue to tell the world about Him, I pray this song is a blessing to you.
