Advent Sunday Morning Bible Study

For many, "advent" means a countdown to Christmas. Whether we envision candy-filled Advent calendars or lights draped over houses with nativity scenes out front, Advent marks a happy season of celebrating. In most Christian traditions, Advent is a four-week season of celebration and observation prior to Christmas, each week often focusing on a particular biblical theme. Typically, these four themes find their way into the weeks of advent: Hope, Peace, Joy and Love. Celebrating Advent also means living into it by practicing a generous way of love and care for our neighbors as we partner with Jesus to bring peace on Earth. Join us as we meditate on each of these themes so that you might deepen your understanding of Advent and experience the season in a new way.



Creation Museum and the Ark

Encounter Are you interested in biblical history with exhibits, botanical gardens, planetarium and zoo animals? What about Noah's Ark? In Petersburg, Kentucky is the Creation Museum which allows you to venture through biblical history in 7 parts called the Seven C's beginning with Creation and a walk through the Garden of Eden. Then 40 miles away in Williamstown, KY is the Ark Encounter. The Ark features a full size Noah's Ark that is 3 decks filled with exhibits that allow you to experience what Noah's life may have been like. This trip would be 5-6 days, which includes travel days and 3 days at the Museum and the Ark, We are able to get a 3 Day Bouncer Pass which offers unlimited visits to both attractions. We could do a day and a half at each. The parking is extra. We could include a river cruise on the Ohio River if there is interest and would be optional. The costs will include transportation, lodging, the pass with parking and nutrition. No date has been decided. Please text or email me (I will be out of the country from Oct 8th to Nov 5th, but still available by email). I hope to be available at church on Nov 9th for questions.
