

College Bible Study



Orders for both greens and poinsettias must be completed online or turned in by 10:00pm on Sunday, Oct. 26th.



Creation Museum and the Ark

Encounter Are you interested in biblical history with exhibits, botanical gardens, planetarium and zoo animals? What about Noah's Ark? In Petersburg, Kentucky is the Creation Museum which allows you to venture through biblical history in 7 parts called the Seven C's beginning with Creation and a walk through the Garden of Eden. There is an exhibit about Israel during the time of Jesus called Borderland. Then 40 miles away in Williamstown, KY is the Ark Encounter. The Ark features a full size Noah's Ark that is 3 decks filled with exhibits that allow you to experience what Noah's life may have been like. There is a restaurant at each location with other dining options which includes coffee, ice cream and candy. And yes there is some shopping in the Gift Shop. This trip would be 5-6 days, which includes travel days and 3 days at the Museum and the Ark, We are able to get a 3 Day Bouncer Pass which offers unlimited visits to both attractions. We could do a day and a half at each. The parking is extra. We could include a river cruise on the Ohio River if there is interest and would be optional. The costs will include transportation, lodging, the pass with parking and nutrition. No date has been decided.
