Donna Badje coordinated with Ptacek's for the cake and cupcakes, overseeing their delivery and payment.


Pat Armstrong and her sister Donna Wittek created beautiful centerpieces that added a special touch to the event.

Dear Brothers in Christ of Luther Memorial Church (letter from Pastor Luis)

Today we turn to you with a deep sense of thanksgiving and joy in the Lord. As we commemorate this **75th anniversary**, our hearts bow in gratitude to God for your faithfulness and also to you, who have been a channel of blessing for so many lives in Costa Rica. Every step we have taken together reflects that this covenant is not just a human bond, but a divine gift that has brought hope, transformation, and salvation to our community. Marriages that previously lived in a free union have now been formalized in the Lord; young people who did not have opportunities can now access studies; And children who in other churches did not have a leading role are now being instructed in the Gospel through motivational methods that excite and captivate them, awakening in them a deep desire to continue learning. The testimonies of many parents who tell how their children cry because they do not want to be late for a lesson, and even sick people want to attend church, because they love to be in the house of God, are moving. Today we also have machines to create our own books and materials, the fruit of the generosity of **Luther Memorial Church.** Many people have received Jesus' mercy through the food bank, a project that was made possible by your financial support. Likewise, student scholarships and so many other aids—too many to list at this point—have deeply blessed our community.
