Serving on Altar Guild?

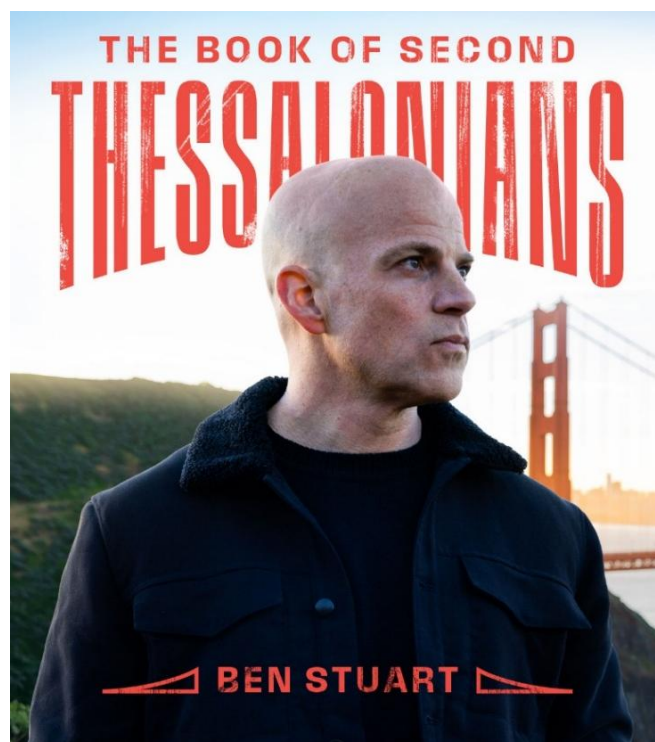

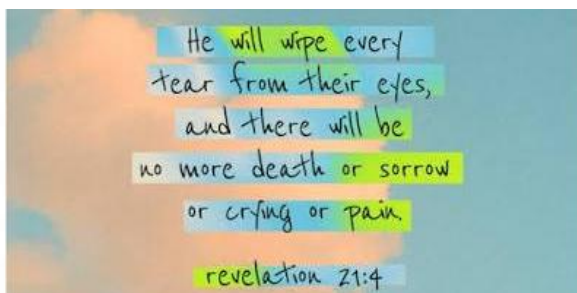
