Like the rest of the world, we have been dealing with the effects of COVID-19.

Our chaplains have been working from home to do their part in the quarantine effort. We knew it wasn't wise to continue to visit multiple dairies each day so we have looked for new ways to reach out and minister.

Like many churches, we have turned to the internet. Our chaplains record devotional videos in Spanish and they are posted on our Facebook pages and our website. We have done our best to get the word out to dairy workers and others about these videos. Their videos are reaching many of the dairy workers, ESL (English as a Second Language) students, and other people we never even thought of! Our chaplain, AB, received a text this week from a woman in Mexico who watched one of his videos last weekend and received Christ! God's ways are incredible! The message of the Gospel went all the way to Mexico while we were quarantined at home!

Our chaplains have also been going "old school" and hand writing personal letters to the many people who have been saved over the past year. They are using this time to encourage and disciple these new Believers. They send a letter and a small Bible study book hoping to inspire them to study the Bible more.

They are also calling workers and ESL students just to check in on them and see how they can pray for them. Last week, our chaplain, Arturo, called one of our ESL students. She was actually in the hospital fixing to have surgery. She was very anxious and in tremendous pain. She was so thankful that he called at just the right time to be able to pray with her! God's timing is perfect!

An old "trucker chapel" has been donated that we can use as a mobile chapel to take to areas where we could host small church services/Bible studies.
