

## ABOUT OUR CHURCH

The Progressive Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Incorporated was founded in 1944 by the late Bishop J. D. Williams, Sr. We believe, preach and teach the principles found in God's Holy Word.

**We Believe** that the Bible is the inspired and **infallible Word of God** (II Timothy 3:16-17). It gives a true history of the creation of the heavens, the earth, and of mankind. We also believe it contains God's roadmap for living a holy life, and it contains a correct prophecy concerning the eternal destiny of mankind.

**We Believe** that there is but **one God** (Deuteronomy 6:4, Galatians 3:20, Ephesians 4:6). In God there is a divine three-fold manifestation and relationship made known as Father, Son, and Holy Ghost (I John 5:7, John 1:1,14). The Lord Jesus Christ is that one God.

**We Believe** that without the **shedding of blood**, there can be no remission of sin (Hebrews 9:22). It is the blood that makes an atonement for the soul. Since mankind was unable to redeem himself due to his fallen nature, Jesus Christ, because of His holy and righteous nature, was the only one qualified to provide atonement (Hebrews 9:11-14).

**We Believe** that to be saved, a person must **repent** and come to God by faith (Hebrews 11:6, Romans 1:16, Mark 16:15-16). The only way an unsaved person can be accepted by God is by repenting of their sins. Repentance is a change of heart, mind, and attitude toward sin. Repentance and remission of sins are preached in His name among all nations (Luke 24:47).

**We Believe** that **water baptism** is an essential part of New Testament salvation. We are buried with Him in baptism (Romans 6:4). Baptism must be administered by immersion in water and in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ (Acts 2:38, Acts 8:16, and Acts 19:5).

**We Believe** that all true believers must be filled with the **Holy Ghost**, evidenced by speaking in other tongues as promised by our Lord (John 7:37-39 and Acts 2:4). The baptism of the Holy Ghost is the birth of the Spirit (John 3:5). One has neither the nature nor the power to live for Christ, nor to perform His work without the Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost is the divine life of Christ dwelling in the believer (Galatians 2:20).

**We Believe** that the Christian life is one of **sanctification and holiness** (I Thessalonians 4:7). After being saved, we are commanded to "go and sin no more." Our lives are to be set apart from sin, consecrated, and dedicated solely to God and for His glory. We are commanded to live soberly, righteously, and godly in this present world (Titus 2:12).
