



# The Messenger



May brings many things. Spring is in the air. New hope fills us as the plants begin to green and flowers begin to bloom. Our tomatoes and peppers are growing in little cups in our dining room, hinting at delicious August and September fruit. No more bland supermarket tomatoes! Talk about being full of hope. But spring also brings its own set of dangers. Tornadoes and wildfire are always lurking in May. Wind and fire. Hmmm.

This reminds me that this year, May brings us through Easter and into Pentecost. The rekindled hope of the disciples upon Jesus' resurrection gives us all a joyous refrain coming out of the cold and darkness of winter. Still, he will not stay. He will ascend into heaven. But we are not left orphaned and alone. Jesus gives us an advocate, a helper and intercessor who goes with us as we continue to follow Jesus. This is the Holy Spirit and the Spirit comes to us like wind and fire.

How strange that these "dangerous" springtime symbols are also the symbols of Pentecost.

I suppose there is a certain amount of danger that comes with living out a Holy Spirit-led life. Frederick Nieder wrote of this in Homilies for the Christian People. He wrote: The Christian story of Pentecost is a story of God as spirit. Fire we can usually contain and overzealous or unwelcome servant which consumes much more than we wish. No wonder that one of the oldest names for God in the Hebrew Scriptures translates to Fire of the Spirit of God blew rushing and mightily upon the disciples and drove them all over the earth, filling them with words which changed many lives but which got almost every last one of them killed. We often pray in words like those of J.S. Bach's Pentecost cantata, "O eternal fire, kindle, ignite our hearts. Let the heavenly flames flare up and penetrate them, for we wish to be thy temple." Do we who dwell in tents dare pray for wind and fire? . . . The Spirit will hold us and with sighs too deep for words she will breathe us back to life. 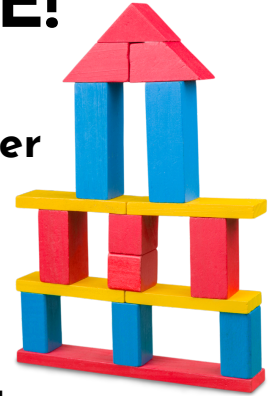

Ministry in Medical Missions

Sante'2000 is continuing its service to the community around Limbe'. Our team had a phone meeting with Dr. Manno and Peter Marc on Sunday April 12, 2026. They shared what are their greatest current needs. The team is working to secure the needed items and will be sending them another shipment soon. We also have made a connection with an Agape mission in Florida that will help get larger items that are needed to the clinic. We were able to ship two wheel chairs through this new connection and that seems to have worked very well. The wheel chair recipients are delighted!

We also continue receiving great support from local hospitals. We obtain some outdated items from the local hospitals that can no longer be used within the USA. However, things that are not more than 1 year past their expiration date can be used by Dr. Manno's clinic. We recently received several boxes of expired wound care supplies from Cloquet Memorial Hospital through this process. This saves these materials from ending up in landfill and greatly assists Dr. Manno's clinic. We have also received diabetic and wound care materials from individuals who had ordered supplies and no longer need them. All of these donations are very valuable. Thank you!

## Congregation Council Minutes 04/21/2026

**Present:** Brad Browers (Worship, Arts and Music), Bob DeCaigny (Secretary), Connor Hecht (President), Lisa Hecht (Stewardship), Linda Holmstrand (Fellowship and WELCA), Pastor Luke Lekander, Shannon Matzdorf (Welcome), Kathy Rye (Past President, Palanca and Church in Society), Marty Rye (Properties), Deb Templeton (Treasurer)

**1. Welcome and Sharing of Highs and Lows:** Members shared as they desired.

**2. Devotion and Opening Prayer:** Connor Hecht – Centered on the spring season.

**3. Approval of March 17, 2026 Meeting Minutes:** The meeting minutes were approved via email.

**4. Treasurer's Report/ Financials**

- Deb provided the following information: for March income was \$23,055 compared to our budget of \$22,058 (\$996 above plan) and expenses were \$27,148 compared to our budget of \$26,259 (\$889 over plan) for a net gain of \$108. Year-to-date 2026 is \$3,465 ahead of plan.

**5. Pastor's Report**

- This past month has been bittersweet. First and foremost, I want to thank Our Savior's for your ongoing prayer and leadership while my family and I grieve the death of my father. With your help, we wrapped up another wonderful Lenten season with meaningful Holy Week and Easter services. Now, in the season of Easter, we had a baptism and I completed my Clinical Pastoral Education unit. It was enriching and helped me grow in ways that will benefit my ministry here in Cloquet. Among other things, we explored Trauma-Informed care, Grief & Loss, Family Systems Theory, Internal Family Systems, Emotions, Genograms, Self Confession, and Appropriate Touch. I named and fulfilled three goals during the unit including a personal goal, an inter-personal goal, and a professional goal. This was truly an enriching and growth-orientated continuing education opportunity. Thank you. Confirmation has entered the home stretch for this school year. We are discussing the students "Big" questions, helping those who will be confirmed in the fall to come up with their faith actions and statements, and we will wrap up on May 6<sup>th</sup> by joining the MSYG in a joint celebration. I completed pre-marital counseling for one couple, presided over one funeral, went on one visit, and baptized one child.

**6. Team Leader Reports**

- **Christian Education:** Six children participated in First Communion class and baked bread for Maundy Thursday service which was when they celebrated their First Communion. We will be meeting on May 3<sup>rd</sup> as a team to discuss future plans for Sunday School, that is the last day of Sunday School for the school year, and we will have an ice cream sundae party. Confirmation wraps up May 6<sup>th</sup>. Registrations for VBS are coming in. Please continue to spread the word. VBS "Mega Sports Camp" is June 22<sup>nd</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> from 8:30 a.m. -- 12:30 p.m. for ages Pre-K - 4th grade.
- **Church Properties:** Nothing new to report.
- **Palanca Deacons:** Nothing new to report.
- **Welcome:** Organized our 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Spirited Sunday event. Music was once again provided by Ryan and Crimsen Hanson of "Crimsen Tied". We had a great turnout. Slightly smaller crowd than last year, but still good. We continue to welcome new members (five new families the past three months—3 of 5 families are returning members).
- **Fellowship:** Planned, helped to prepare, and served the Maundy Thursday Dinner Church. For Easter, the team served coffee and refreshments between services. Volunteers to provide refreshments and/or serve coffee on Sunday mornings are needed. See the signup in the narthex. We welcome two new members to the team!
- **NHCP:** No report
- **Stewardship Team:** Plan to meet in May to explore potential activities for the coming year.
- **Worship, Arts & Music:** The conclusion of Lent, Holy Week, and Easter was a success. Special thanks to all the groups that made these events possible. Just prior to Holy Week, the organ underwent its full annual tuning. Easter saw the implementation of new wireless microphone adapters for the Praise Team vocalists, thanks to a \$1,800 contribution from the Gifts and Memorials team. Easter was also the final performance of the handbell director who has officially resigned. As the season ends, the final choir performance before the summer break will be on May 17<sup>th</sup>. The plan for the Summer is to continue the current rotation of traditional and contemporary services every other week.
- **Youth Ministry:** Middle School Youth group was not held March 25<sup>th</sup> or April 1<sup>st</sup> as schools were on spring break. Attendance has been down due to spring sports, however, new students have been attending. About 15 kids attend per week. On April 8<sup>th</sup> Pastor Luke spoke to a group of students and adults about death and how grieving is healthy. As follow-up to that lesson a study of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus was held April 15<sup>th</sup>. Youth group will conclude May 6<sup>th</sup> by going to Sky Zone with the confirmation students.

**8. New Business**

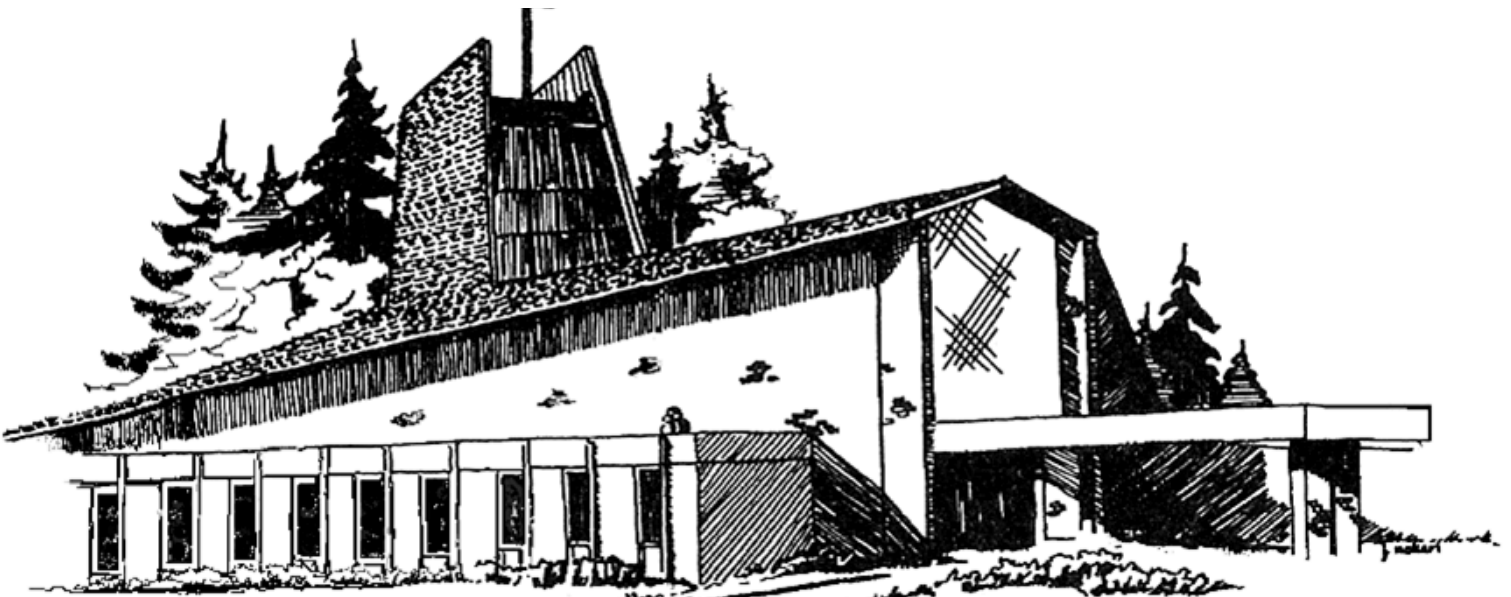
- Congregation Meeting Agenda April 26<sup>th</sup>: The agenda was reviewed.
