EAT PIZZA, HELP ONE COMMUNITY ONE FAMILY

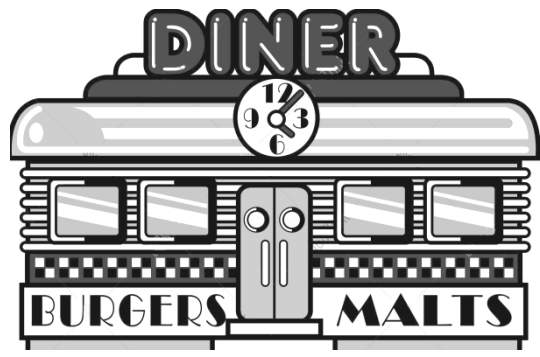
