RSVP TODAY TO GO TO WATER WORLD ON AUGUST 5

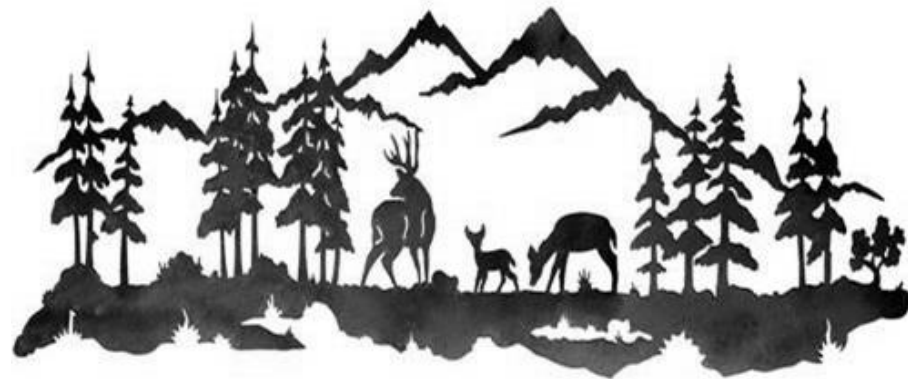
