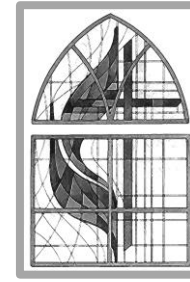

SEARCHERS CLASS TO OBSERVE VETERANS DAY

He will then follow with a personal view of combat that he calls "Vietnam Flashback." HELP THE YOUTH HELP OTHERS!

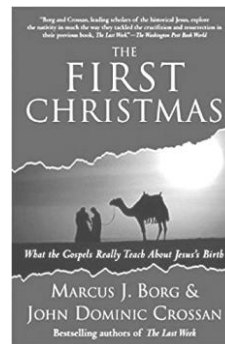
