How long have you been with this organization?

35 years – since June 1981; we first arrived in Ireland in July 1983

Your connection (if any) to First Baptist Church, how we came to support you:

Joyce's parents, Cliff & Helen Lamborn, were members of First Baptist church in the late 1970's and '80's until they moved out of the area. We were very much "adopted" by the congregation through Cliff and Helen. David Sommerfield was pastor of the church at the time.

How long has First Baptist Church been a supporter of your mission?

Since before we left for Ireland in 1983.

Do you currently need more financial support? If yes, what amount?

Yes, we recently had a major reduction in our support and need to raise an additional \$2500 per month (due to the low oil prices and more of our ministry partners are retiring now or have passed away). We also need to raise an additional \$5000 to maintain a buffer in our account which the mission requires that we have for contingencies.

What is your Life Verse and/or favorite Bible Verse?

For Jesse – "So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness." – Colossians 2:6-7

For Joyce – "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider him who endured such opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart." – Hebrews 12:2-3
