- 5. With the gospel as a priority, what should that say practically to what is heard in the church when the Word of God is preached every Sunday?
- 6. What do we learn about the power of the gospel from Paul's own story of his salvation and his call as an apostle?
- 7. What is the role of grace in Paul's conversion and calling? What would you say to someone struggling with fear about being too sinful for God to save?
- 8. When is the last time you shared the gospel with an unbeliever? Who are you praying for to have an opportunity?
- 9. When is the last time you shared the gospel with yourself? How can this group pray for you in this?
