3. In what ways have you experienced God as a refuge and rock as David did?
4. How do you describe God to an unbeliever?
5. Would you say 2 Samuel 22 accurately sums up David's life and his relationship with God? Why?
6. In linking God's rescue of David to what God did for the nation of Israel at the Red Sea and Mt. Sinai, what does that say about God's redemptive love for people?
7. In v21-25 David speaks as though he were sinless, yet in Ps 51 he is aware of his sin. How do you account for this? How could David make such claims about himself?
8. How does this passage exalt Jesus?
9. Do you ever feel like God is too big for you to relate to or understand? How can you make Him smaller?
10. After studying the question for two weeks now, is it okay if your life has not turned out like you thought it would? Why?
