4. Why did Jesus not come as a victorious king the first time? If he had come to dispense justice, what would have happened to you?
5. How does God use Pilate to announce Jesus as the prophesied King?
6. What lies do you hear about happiness apart from God? How does the gospel respond to those specific lies?
7. What does this passage reveal about Jesus that you need to believe today?
8. Read 2 Corinthians 5:14–15. Does this passage make Paul's words more personal for you? Why?
