6. What people, places, or things remind you of the presence of God? Why?
7. What is your daily routine for spending time with God? How do you keep it from becoming just a routine? Do difficult times in life make it easier or harder? Why?
8. Spend some time talking about how much God loves us. Does this change how much you love him?
9. What are some ways to grow in your love for God when you don't feel a lot of affection for him?
10. The reality of God's love does not mean we will not suffer. How can God's love change our perspective on suffering?
