Jesus Is The True King Psalm 72

1. If you are comfortable sharing, what has been the biggest disappointment of your life? What about the other way around. How have you caused someone else's disappointment?
2. Jesus told us to pray Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven (Matt 6.10). Do you think the good works we do now can help usher in the kingdom of God? Why or Why not? If God has prepared good works for us in advance (Eph 2.10), what might those be for you right now in this season of your life?
3. Jesus said Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest (Matt 11.28). How does Jesus give rest to your weary soul? Who can you share this with that might be weary right now?
4. When compared to Jesus, the only true King, it does not leave us much hope for our human leaders. Which specific leaders could you begin praying for that God's favor and blessing would rest on?
5. When is the last time you felt genuine compassion over a situation in someone else's life? What did you do about it?
6. Can you honestly say that Jesus is your King? If so, then what about your life reveals His rule? If not, then who is?
7. If you were given only this psalm to work with, how would you explain the Messiah to someone else?
8. Out of everything we talked about from this psalm, what did the Holy Spirit use to speak to you most clearly? Now that He's shown you that, what are you going to do about it?
